



REQUIREMENTS FOR A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NORMAL GRADE PETROLEUM (NON- PRESSURISED) CONSUMER SITE STORAGE SITE

Requirements for one to apply for a construction permit:

1. Company registration certificates of the firm operating site
2. ID copies of the directors
3. EIA report for the project as submitted to NEMA and listing possible impacts arising from temporary storage of petroleum & its mitigation measures
4. Valid EIA license from NEMA approving the development of the project.
5. Development permission from the respective County Government (including County Physical Planning Office)
6. Approved construction drawings by the respective County Government for:
 - a. **Mechanical engineer's drawings** specifying materials and design/operational limitations (product piping, above-ground tank(s), filling facility, water draw off fittings, location, pump vents, pumps etc)
 - b. **Civil engineer's drawings** (all civil works including drainage, Oil Water Separator, bund walls, tank pad/ foundation, hard standing surfaces e.t.c)

NOTE: (1) All drawings are to be done by respective class of professional engineers or firm(s) registered as such (**attach proof**). These shall, at minimum, take into consideration the Kenya Standards and in particular KS 1967:2006 & KS-IEC series standards, and in particular API Standard 650 for tank constructions.

(2) Review of an application takes a **maximum** of 45 days subject to a site visit.
