



REQUIREMENTS FOR A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PETROLEUM PIPELINE

Requirements for one to apply for a construction permit:

1. Company registration certificates of the firm developing the land
2. ID copies of the directors
3. Proof of way leave/ right of way acquisition (**copy of duly executed ownership documents or lease agreement with the landowners** and in the name of the applying Company).
4. Valid EIA license from NEMA specifically authorizing development of LPG facility.
5. Development permission from the respective County Government (including County Physical Planning Office)
6. Where way leaves or right of ways are shared, consent from all users of the way leaves by a minimum of a senior engineering officer and the CEO (or in his absence the person with *power of attorney*) from each of the companies using the way leaves/ right of ways.
7. Approved construction drawings by the respective County Government for:
 - a. Mechanical engineer's drawings specifying materials and design/ operational limitations (pressure, product contents, corrosion protection, pipe size and approved safety fittings)
 - b. Civil engineer's drawings (support structures, pipeline road/ rail crossings & associated impact protection details, hydraulic calculations)
8. Write up on quality control measures/ strategies for the completed pipeline.

NOTE: (1) All drawings are to be done by respective class of professional engineers or firm(s) registered as such (**attach proof**). These shall, at minimum, take into consideration the Kenya Standards where available or in their absence equivalent ISO, ASME, API standards/ codes.

(2) Review of an application takes a **maximum** of 45 days subject to a site visit.
