MAXIMUM RETAIL PUMP PRICES IN KENYA FOR THE PERIOD 15TH JULY - 14TH AUGUST 2018

14TH JULY 2018

In accordance with Legal Notice No.196 of 2010, the Energy (Petroleum Pricing) Regulations and the amendment thereof, the Energy Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has calculated the maximum retail pump prices of petroleum products which will be in force from 15th July to 14th August 2018.

Taking into account the weighted average cost of imported refined petroleum products, the changes in the maximum allowed petroleum pump prices in Nairobi are as follows: Super Petrol increases by KShs. 3.39 while Diesel and Kerosene decrease by KShs. 0.35 and KShs. 1.48 per litre respectively.

The changes in this month's prices have been as a consequence of the average landed cost of imported Super Petrol increasing by 5.54% from US\$ 700.01 per ton in May 2018 to US\$ 738.77 per ton in June 2018; Diesel decreasing by 1.11% from US\$ 689.62 per ton to US\$ 681.99 per ton and Kerosene decreasing by 1.91% from US\$ 745.54 per ton to US\$ 731.27 per ton. The changes in the landed costs are summarized in the table below:

The Free On board (FOB) price of Murban crude oil lifted in June 2018 was posted at US\$ 77.20 per barrel, a **decrease** of 1.34% from US\$ 78.25 per barrel in May 2018.

Over the same period, the mean monthly US Dollar to Kenya Shilling exchange rate depreciated by 0.14% from KShs. 100.87 per US\$ in May 2018 to KShs. 101.01 per US\$ in June 2018.

A summary of the resultant pump prices for major towns in Kenya is provided as Annex I. In addition, a detailed breakdown and a progression of the cost items for the pump prices in Nairobi are provided as Annex II and III for information. The table below shows the trend of monthly crude oil prices and exchange rates for the last 12 months:

The purpose of the fuel pricing regulations is to cap the pump prices of the products which are already in the country, so that the importation and other prudently incurred costs are recovered, while ensuring reasonable prices to consumers. The actual pipeline loss factor has been calculated at 0.10% which is a reduction from the standard factor of 0.25%. Accordingly, the savings per litre on account of the reduced pipeline loss are as follows: Super Petrol KShs.0.15, Diesel KShs.0.14 and Kerosene KShs.0.11 respectively.

The Commission wishes to assure the general public of its continued commitment to the observance of fair competition and protection of the interests of both consumers and investors in the energy and petroleum sectors. As part of petroleum motor fuels quality management, consumer protection and prevention of tax evasion, the Commission undertakes petroleum fuels marking and monitoring to deter motor fuels adulteration and dumping of export bound petroleum products into the local market.

Over the years, the program has been successful with a compliance level of about 97%. Recently, the Commission in collaboration with the National Police Service undertook successful operations in Uasin Gishu and Bungoma Counties where seven (7) unlicensed petroleum storage sites were demolished and operators charged.

Motor fuels adulteration is detrimental to the economy with conservative estimates putting the total loss to the country at KShs.9.2 billion per annum. This is in addition to high vehicle maintenance costs that result after consumption of adulterated fuels. The Commission urges motorists who experience jerking, excessive smoke from the exhaust, loss of engine power and sometimes complete engine stalls immediately after fueling to report to the Commission through hot line numbers: 0708 444 000 and 0709 336 000. This will enable the Commission to undertake comprehensive tests of the motor fuels in the suspect retail station and sanction the operator in the event of non-conforming motor fuels. To this end, consumers are urged to always obtain receipts or retain evidence of transactions whenever they purchase petroleum fuels from retail stations.






