LEGAL NOTICE NO. 96

THE ENERGY ACT

(No. 12 of 2006)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 102 of the Energy Act, 2006, the Minister for Energy makes the following Regulations:—

THE ENERGY (IMPORTATION OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS)  
(QUOTA ALLOCATION) REGULATIONS, 2010

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Energy (Importation of Petroleum Products) (Quota Allocation) Regulations, 2010. Citation.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.

“import requirements” means the quantities of crude oil and various petroleum products imported for consumption in Kenya in any given year;

“Petroleum products quota allocation” means the portion of import requirements, allocated for importation by the National oil corporation of Kenya, as established under Regulation 3 of these Regulations.

3. (1) There is established a portion of the import requirements to be known the petroleum products quota allocation. Petroleum products quota allocation.

(2) The petroleum products quota allocation shall be imported by the National Oil Corporation of Kenya.

(3) The petroleum products Quota Allocation shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto.
